It is supported by "called out ones of Yahweh." which is the meaning of "Assembly of Yahweh." It is for those hearing and heeding the call of Revelation 18:4, and is proclaiming to the world that Yahweh reigns, Psalm 96.

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EDITORIAL

The Passover Season

Yahweh Almighty has set a season for us to remember His son Yahshua the Messiah. He wants us to remove the sin out of our lives, before we partake of Yahshua the Messiah's emblems of life.

The fruit of the vine (Luke 22:18 – representing his blood) – Leviticus 17:11, For the life of the flesh is in the blood: ... for it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul. Yahshua's own words in Matthew 26:27-28 – Drink ye all of it; For this is my blood of the New Testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.

The unleavened bread – Matthew 26:26 ... Yahshua took bread, and blessed it, and brake it, and gave it to the disciples, and said, take, eat; this is my body.

Apostle Paul's record of this occasion in 1 Corinthians 11:23-26 reads, ... the Master Yahshua the same night in which he was betrayed took bread: And when he had given thanks, he brake it, and said, take eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of me. After the same manner also he took the cup, when he had supped, saying, This cup is the New Testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of me (Strong's #364, from #363 – recollection, to remind, call to mind). For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this cup, ye do show the Master's death till he come.

With the verses 27-30 comes a strong warning to the partakers – Wherefore whosoever shall eat this bread, and drink this cup of the Master unworthily (Strong's #370 and 371, irreverently), shall be guilty of the body and blood of the Master. But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup. For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Master's body. For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep (die).

It is a serious thing to fall unto the hands of the Almighty. Paul continues in verses 30 and 31 – For if we would judge ourselves, we should not be judged. But when we are judged, we are chastened of the Master, that we should not be condemned with the world. Paul knew firsthand about falling from grace and receiving forgiveness. His own life (his journey to Damascus to persecute the believers) was a good example of man failing and Yahshua forgiving.

How did Yahshua know mankind would sin and need a Saviour to die for their commandment or law breaking? Was Yahshua's existence in the plan right from the point in time in Genesis 1:26 – And Elohim said, Let us make man in our image ... Was Yahweh speaking to Yahshua? This is a possibility if the record by Apostle Paul in Colossians is correct. Colossians 1:13-23 – Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son: In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins: Who is the image of the invisible Elohim, the firstborn of all creation: For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him: And he is before all things, and by him all things consist. And he is the head of the body, the assembly: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things he might have the preeminence. For it pleased the Father that in him should all fullness dwell; And, having made peace through the blood of his stake, by him to reconcile all things

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unto himself; by him, I say, whether they be things in earth, or things in heaven. And you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled In the body of his flesh through death, to present you holy (kodesh) and unblameable and unreproveable in his sight: If ye continue in the faith grounded and settled, and be not moved away from the hope of the good news, which ye have heard, and which was preached to every creature which is under heaven; whereof I Paul am made a minister;

The memorial season of Passover was a very important appointment in Israel under King Hezekiah's reign, around 726 BCE. King Hezekiah sent to all Israel and Judah and wrote letters also to Ephraim and Manasseh that they should come to the house of Yahweh at Jerusalem, to keep the Passover unto Yahweh Elohim of Israel. See 2 Chronicles 30:1-3. For the king had taken counsel, and his princes, and all the congregation in Jerusalem, to keep the Passover in the second month (Iyar). For they could not keep it at that time, because the priests had not sanctified themselves sufficiently, neither had the people gathered themselves together to Jerusalem.

An important appointment also, in Numbers the 9th chapter – Moses spake unto the children of Israel, that they should keep the Passover. There were certain men, who were defiled by the dead body of a man, that they could not keep the Passover on that day: and they came before Moses and before Aaron on that day: And those men said unto him, We are defiled by the dead body of a man: wherefore are we kept back, that we may not offer an offering of Yahweh in his appointed season among the children of Israel? And Moses said unto them, Stand still, and I will hear what Yahweh will command concerning you. And <u>Yahweh</u> spake unto Moses, saying, Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, If any man of you or of your posterity shall be unclean by reason of a dead body, or be in a journey afar off, yet he shall keep the Passover unto Yahweh. The fourteenth day of the second month between the evenings they shall keep it, and eat it with unleavened bread and bitter herbs.

There are those today who would discount the importance of keeping/observing Yahweh's commands. The outcome, however, of obeying Yahweh's commands are blessings. Most, if not all, creation would rather have blessings instead of cursings. See Deuteronomy chapters 27 and 28 for the blessings and cursings. "And it shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of Yahweh thy Elohim, to observe and to do all his commandments which I command thee this day, that Yahweh thy Elohim will set thee on high above all nations of the earth." Blessed shalt thou be in the city, and blessed shalt thou be in the field. Blessed shalt thou be when thou comest in, and blessed shalt thou be when thou goest out.

Let us make our plans to obey Yahweh by keeping/observing only His set apart days.

You know, the book is not closed. Psalm 98 tells us to "sing unto Yahweh a **new** song!" It doesn't take a lot of talent to put your thoughts on paper. They don't have to be set to music. They just have to be you and your praise of Almighty Yahweh. As it says at the end of the book (Ps. 150:6): "Let everything that hath breath praise Yah. **HALLELUYAH!**"

IN PRAISE OF THE PSALTER

Here at Eaton Rapids we love to read from the book of Psalms. Not a service goes by without at least one Psalm reading. On many Sabbaths two or three Psalms are read. We find that it's a good opportunity to get everyone involved in the Scriptures. Even the young men are sometimes called upon to pick one of their favorite Psalms, lead the congregation in its reading and then most importantly tell us what it means to them.

Everyone has their favorite Psalm don't they... The great thing about this book is that there is something in it for everyone. The writers of the Psalms run the gamut in personality, experience, social standing, etc... There is something for every occasion. When we're happy we can sing the Halleluyah Psalms (146-150) with all our heart and soul. When we're sad or grief stricken we can pronounce Psalm 88 in our mourning. I thought that we could spend a little time reviewing this masterpiece of poetic literature and divine inspiration. Join me as we walk through this book and hopefully gain a deeper understanding of its meaning and content.

Often called the Prayer Book of the Second Temple, the book of Psalms is quoted in the New Testament more than any other book. The common English title "Psalms" comes from the Septuagint, an ancient Greek translation of the scriptures. The term actually refers to the playing of stringed instruments. In the Hebrew Scriptures the book is called "Tehillim" which translates as PRAISES. It contains 150 chapters – more than any other book in the Bible. Did you know that there are actually five collections of books within the Psalter? Sounds familiar doesn't it? It's commonly believed that the final compilers of the book patterned the collections after the five books of Moses, commonly called the Torah.

Psalms 1-41 comprise the first collection. These are often thought to be the oldest of the Psalms. They are also the most personal in nature and content. Many of them were written by David himself and he is commonly believed to be the compiler of this section. Psalms 1 and 2 form a nice introduction to the entire book. Psalm 1 starts with "Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the wicked, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. But his delight is in the law of Yahweh; and in his law doth he meditate day and night." This should be taken together with the ending of Psalm 2: "Kiss the Son, lest he be angry, and ye perish from the way, when his wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all they that put their trust in him." Is this not our Faith in a nut shell? "To the law and to the testimony: if they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no light in them!" (Isa. 8:20).

Psalms 42-72 comprise the second collection. These are believed by many to have been collected and grouped by King Solomon. They are more universal in nature and contain seven prayers for Jerusalem, the King and the community at the center of the collection. Psalm 55 contains some good advice that I have tried to apply in my own life: "**Evening** and **morning**, and at **noon**, will I pray, and cry aloud: and he shall hear my voice." v17 How much better would our days go if we were diligent in coming before Him *at least* three times...

Psalms 73-89 comprise the third collection, often thought to be compiled by the priestly clan of Korahites. The Korahites are mentioned as door keepers and musicians in David's tabernacle as well as the temple of Solomon. This gives the words of Psalm 84:10 more weight: "For a day in thy courts is better than a thousand. I had rather be a *doorkeeper* in the house of my Elohim, than to dwell in the tents of wickedness."

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Psalms 90-106, the fourth collection is liturgical in nature and again is believed to have been brought together by David himself. These Psalms are filled with the celebration of Yahweh's righteous rule. Certainly everyone can recite verses 1 and 2 of Psalm 91: "He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of Yahweh, He is my refuge and my fortress: my Elohim; in Him will I trust."

Psalms 107-150, comprising the fifth collection, contain many Psalms written during the Babylonian exile. These are filled with raw emotion and most probably were collected and ordered by that great post exilic leader Ezra. If you want to begin committing some of the Psalms to memory I suggest you start with Psalm 117. It's only two verses: "O praise Yahweh, all ye nations: praise him all ye peoples. For his merciful kindness is great toward us: and the truth of Yahweh endureth for ever. Halleluyah!"

Within the five collections there are also smaller sub-units with common themes or authors. Psalms 73-83 are known as the *Psalms of Asaph*. We can read of him in 1 Chronicles chapter 16. Asaph was a great musician and choir leader appointed by King David himself. Psalms 113-118 are known as the *Egyptian Hallel*. These were often sung during the three great pilgrimage feasts. Travelling worshippers would also sing Psalms 120-134 as they were on the way to the temple. Thus they are called the *Psalms of Ascents*.

There are many types of Psalms in the five collections. They were not all meant to be sung. A welcome realization for those of us who can only "make a joyful **noise** unto Yahweh" (Ps. 98:4) There are laments, confessions, prayers, songs of thanksgiving and praise, teaching Psalms and prophecies. Some Psalms are specifically written for worship in the Assembly. Psalm 136 is an example of a Responsive Psalm. One in which the leader of the congregation makes his statement and then is followed by a response from the congregation. In this case the refrain is "for his mercy endureth forever". There are 26 recitations in all, which just happens to be the numerical equivalent of the Sacred Name. Is this a coincidence? I think not! Isn't it amazing that people have been reciting this Psalm together for almost 3000 years? What a tradition! I praise Almighty Yahweh for allowing me this fellowship with believers of old.

Many of the Psalms have very complex structures. Psalms 25, 34, 37, 119 and 145 are what's called Alphabetic Acrostics. Each verse starts with a sequential letter of the Hebrew alphabet. All Psalms are poetry. At the heart of all poetry is rhythm. In English, rhythm is achieved by repetition of the sound or accent of words. In the Psalms, rhythm is achieved by the repetition of **thoughts** or **ideas** as in Psalm 27:1 "Yahweh is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? Yahweh is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?"

Many, many authors are represented in the Book of Psalms. By my count 73 were written by David, 11 by Asaph, 2 by Solomon and 1 by Moses. Scattered here and there we have Psalms with other authors referenced but fully a third of all the Psalms are anonymous. Brethren, in many cases, these Psalms were written by people like you and me. Some of these people were overwhelmed by grief as in Psalm 102. Raw human emotion is often poured out within these pages (i.e. Ps. 137). These books represent 1000 years of the voices of the faithful! It is an honor to have them in our hands, to take them on our lips, to dwell upon them in our spirits.

We should cherish these Psalms brethren! We should memorize our favorites and teach our children to do the same. Let's put down the cell phones and shut off the computers occasionally and meditate on the **thoughts** and **ideas** of believers in days past.

In the modern civilized world MANY ARE WALKING IN DARKNESS concerning spiritual things. THE SACRED NAME

In this tract the SACRED NAME of the HEAVENLY FATHER and of the SAVIOUR will be used. The Father's Name is YAHWEH (Yah Eternal) and the Son's Name is YAHSHUA (Yah Salvation).

Due to a Jewish superstition which regarded the Divine Name as too sacred to be uttered, "ADONAY" was SUBSTITUTED for the TETRAGRAMMATON (YHWH). This Memorial Name (YHWH), explained in Exodus 3:14-15, and emphasized as such over and over in the original text of the Old Testament, designates the Almighty as a personal Mighty One, as the Covenant Elohim, the Elohim of revelation, the Deliverer and the Friend of His people. This PERSONAL NAME should be RESTORED to the place in the sacred texts to which it has an unquestionable claim.

ONE LANGUAGE

In the beginning, "the whole earth had ONE LANGUAGE" (Genesis 11:1), and then approximately 2245 B.C. man decided to "build a city, and a tower with its top in the heavens," and to "make a name" for themselves. (Genesis 11:4) Yahweh saw that this was only the beginning of the things that man would do so He "CONFUSED THEIR LANGUAGE" and they were unable to "UNDERSTAND ONE ANOTHER'S SPEECH." (Genesis 11:7) Man was then scattered abroad on the face of all the earth. When man's time as ruler of this earth is ended and Yahweh's time begins, "He will change the language of the peoples to a pure language, that all of them may call on the name of Yahweh and serve Him with one accord." (Zephaniah 3:9) In that day, He will be "king over all the earth" and "His name one." (Zechariah 14:9) People will NOT be

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calling on the Mighty One in the various names and titles used today, but "from the rising of the sun to its setting" HIS NAME, YAHWEH, will be "GREAT AMONG THE NATIONS" (Malachi 1:11), and "EVERY KNEE SHALL BOW" to His Name. (Philippians 2:9-11, Isaiah 45:23). Halleluyah!

YAHWEH'S LAW

All who are interested in spiritual living will tell you that they believe and keep the Ten Commandments. They are referring to Matthew 22:36-40, where the lawyer asked Yahshua, "Master, which is the great commandment in the law?" Yahshua answered, "Thou shalt love Yahweh, thy Elohim, with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself" This was NOT a NEW law but a SUMMARY of the same Ten Commandments given on Mt. Sinai. This answer did not ELIMINATE the THIRD or the FOURTH COMMANDMENTS. How can our pastors of today teach that the Sabbath (7th Day) was nailed to the tree? Yahweh Himself worked six days and RESTED THE 7th. (Genesis 1:1-31, Genesis 2:1-2) Let us notice that He worked FIRST and then rested. If we keep the first day of the week, we rest first and then work. Are we then obeying Yahweh? The Sabbath was made for MAN. (Mark 2:27) The Scripture does not say the Sabbath was made for the JEWS. The word "MAN" INCLUDES BOTH MEN AND WOMEN of every nationality, for the Sabbath was given to Adam and Eve who are the ancestors of all nationalities. Remember the LAW of Moses (Malachi 4:4) and be not guilty of causing "many to stumble at the LAW." (Malachi 2:8) "Know ye not, brethren, how that LAW hath dominion over a man as long as he lives?" (Romans 7:1) In Romans 13:9, the last six commandments are explained as the meaning of loving thy neighbor as thyself. To go a bit further, verse ten tells us that "LOVE IS THE FULFILLING OF THE LAW." If we love Yahweh will we not keep His Sabbath and use His Name? We have long been taught that the word "VAIN" in the 3rd commandment means to SWEAR. However, from the Hebrew we know it has a much deeper meaning, for Strong's Concordance gives its meaning as TO DESOLATE, TO SUBSTITUTE. Let us read the third commandment this way "THOU SHALT NOT SUFFER THE NAME OF YAHWEH, THY ELOHIM, TO BECOME DESOLATE; FOR YAHWEH WILL NOT HOLD WHOSOEVER ALLOWETH HIS NAME TO BE FALSIFIED." Does this not mean we are not to substitute Lord God for the Name of Yahweh? Brothers and Sisters, we are not just to KEEP the Ten Commandments, but we are to DO them!

YAHWEH'S TIME

From the record of the very first day on the earth, we learn how Yahweh MARKS OFF THE DAYS BY EVENINGS AND MORNINGS. (Genesis 1:5-31) The day consists of TWO parts with the evening coming FIRST. Yahweh instructed the Israelites, "From even unto even, shall ye celebrate your Sabbath." (Leviticus 23:32) "Even," or evening, BEGINS "at the going down of the sun." (Deuteronomy 16:6) Yah's holy day begins and ends at sunset. Yahshua said, "Are there not 12 hours in the day?" (John 11:9) But we must understand that the first hour began at sunrise and that the light part of the day was then DIVIDED into 12 EQUAL PARTS. The evening began at sunset and then the dark part of the day was DIVIDED INTO 4 WATCHES. In approximately 146 B.C., the sundial was constructed from Rome and this instrument was used to subdivide the day into equal parts. Each of these 12 parts were NOT always 60 minutes long as we know an hour today. They didn't have the 12-hour clock that we have today. In Isaiah 38:8, we

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find reference to the sundial being used to calculate time. This was approximately 700 years prior to the Saviour's birth. At Passover time in the spring, since the DAY AND NIGHT ARE EQUAL, the light part of the day could be determined from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. and the dark part of the day from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. The same is true in the fall at Feast of Tabernacles time.

BIRTH AND DEATH OF OUR SAVIOUR

All the Christian world celebrates the birth of the Saviour on December 25th. IS THIS BIBLICAL? We can tell the season of Yahshua's birth only one way – by studying the TWENTY-FOUR COURSES. Please turn to Exodus 12:2. Yahweh is saying, "This month shall be unto you the BEGINNING of months: it shall be the FIRST MONTH of the year to you." This was a religious year. In Exodus 13:4 we learn that this month was to be called "ABIB," which means "GREEN EARS." This was spring. 1 Chronicles 24:1-18 tells us that there were to be twenty-four courses and the course of Abiyah was the eighth. Since there are 12 months in a year, this meant that there would be TWO COURSES EACH MONTH. Now turn to Luke 1:5-25 and we see Zacharias, while serving the Course of Abiyah, being told by an angel that his wife, Elizabeth, would bear a son who should be named John.

After finishing the COURSE OF ABIYAH, Zacharias departed to his house and after these days his wife CONCEIVED. In verses 26 to 38, Gabriel, the angel, is visiting Miriam, IN THE 6TH MONTH OF ELIZABETH'S PREGNANCY, to tell her of her CONCEPTION of Yahshua. This means that Miriam conceived Yahshua by the Holy Spirit when Elizabeth was six months pregnant. Let us list the months of the Hebrews and the corresponding months as we know them today:

- * John the Baptist was conceived in the FOURTH MONTH, TAMUZ (after the course of Abiyah).
- # Yahshua was conceived in the TENTH MONTH, TEVETH (6 months after John was conceived).
- x Count nine months from Teveth and we come to the 7^{th} month, TISHRI, which is equivalent to our SEPTEMBER or OCTOBER.

The Saviour was born AROUND THE FEAST OF TABERNACLES. The sheep were still in the fields. His parents were going to Bethlehem to be taxed.

Why are people willing to celebrate that which Yahweh did NOT request, but FAIL TO OBEY His requests? He did NOT ask us to remember Yahshua's birth but HIS DEATH. How are we to remember His death? WHEN? We are to remember Yahshua's

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death at the SAME TIME He INSTITUTED the FEET WASHING (John 13:4-12) and the PARTAKING OF THE EMBLEMS, representing His body and blood. (Matthew 26:26-29) Turn to 1 Corinthians 11:23 and we find that this time is the same night in which He was betrayed, or the DARK PART of the 14th of Abib. This is to be done ANNUALLY. He DIED on the tree at the NINTH HOUR OF THE 14th OF ABIB and was put into the tomb JUST BEFORE SUNSET. (Luke 23:44-46; 53-56)

He, Himself, said he would rise in "THREE DAYS AND THREE NIGHTS." (Matthew 12:40) How could this be a Friday crucifixion and a Sunday resurrection? For a full study concerning the crucifixion and the resurrection write for a separate tract which has been prepared.

CHRISTMAS CELEBRATION

We have learned that the Saviour was NOT BORN on December 25. But what of our tree with the many ornaments? Jeremiah 10:1-4 tells us "Learn not the way of the nations, and be not dismayed at the signs of heaven; for the nations are dismayed at them. For the customs of the people are vanity; for one cutteth a tree out of the forest, the work of the hands of the workman with the axe. They deck it with silver and with gold; they fasten it with nails and with hammers, that it move not."

As for the little man in the red suit, whom everyone calls Santa Claus, he is another instrument of Satan to distract us from truly worshipping Yahshua. Some call him "Saint Nick." Who is "Old Nick?" The devil has been referred to in this name hasn't he? Shall we TURN AWAY from these PAGAN PRACTICES and OBEY OUR HEAVENLY FATHER? Oh! What joy would be in heaven if all came to this knowledge!

TITHES AND OFFERINGS

"Will a man rob Elohim? Yet ye have robbed me. But ye say, wherein have we robbed thee? In tithes and offerings. Ye are cursed with a curse; for ye have robbed me" (Malachi 3:8-9)

TEN CENTS OF EVERY DOLLAR WE EARN BELONGS TO YAHWEH. Are we missing a blessing by not obeying the Word? This does not mean we are to give all our money to the church to support the pastors for we find in Deuteronomy 26:12 that it is to be DIVIDED FOUR WAYS: the pastor, the stranger, the fatherless and the widow.

DAILY SCRIPTURAL READING

We are to GROW DAILY in our spiritual life. To do this we must study to approve ourselves. (2 Timothy 2:15) This does not mean to study or hear a sermon once a week, but to study our bibles DAILY with prayer. Every family needs a bible in the home not to collect dust but to be worn from constant use.

FOODS ORDAINED BY YAHWEH

Who should know what is best for us but our Creator. Listen to His Word! Deuteronomy 14:6 tells us we may eat of "every beast that parteth the hoof and cleaveth the cleft into two claws, and cheweth the cud among the beasts." This does NOT include such animals as the swine (pork), rabbit, camel, or any animal that does not have all of the specifications mentioned above. Of the water we may eat "all that have fins and scales." (verse 9) This EXCLUDES shrimp, clams, oysters and lobster. "Of all clean birds ye shall eat." (verse 11) Read verses 12 to 19 to understand the kinds of fowl you are not to eat. For another reference to the command of Yahweh concerning flesh food, read the 11th chapter of Leviticus.

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Many will say 1 Timothy 4:4 states that we may eat of every creature. Let us read this verse, "For every creature of Yahweh is good, and nothing to be refused, if it be received with thanksgiving: for IT IS SANCTIFIED by the Word of Yahweh and prayer." Are all foods sanctified by Yahweh? No! We must go back to Deuteronomy 14 and Leviticus 11 to learn what is SANCTIFIED by Yahweh. So the question remains, shall we obey Yahweh or do as we please? The Creator has warned us as he warned Adam and Eve in Eden.

What EXCUSE will we give for our DISOBEDIENCE?

THE MARK

In Revelation 13:16-18 we read of the Beast (meaning the government) causing all to receive A MARK. Revelation 14:9-10 warns us what will happen if we receive THE MARK. We believe that the mark has to do with the Commandments, especially in regard to the Sabbath. But we feel the full impact of the mark has NOT yet been made. It will have something perhaps to do with the CHANGE OF OUR CALENDAR, which is being advocated by many. In fact, the Ecumenical Council in its future gatherings plans to consider the revision of the calendar on its agenda. This change for the first time in history BREAKS THE CONTINUITY of the seven day week instituted by Yahweh when He blessed the first "Seventh Day" as the Sabbath of Yahweh.

Dear ones, we must be wise and "watch and pray" that we enter not into temptation. Let us be led by the Holy Spirit in all Truth and "be filled with the Spirit" that we may be able to stand for Yahweh when that mark is given.

Let us keep our eyes open. He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith. Halleluyah!

ETERNITY – HEAVEN OR EARTH?

Many have been taught that the world (earth) will come to an end and the righteous will spend eternity in heaven. What do that Scriptures say? "The heaven, even the heavens, are Yahweh's; but the earth hath He given to the children of men." (Psalm 115:16) "... the earth abideth for ever." (Ecclesiastes 1:4) Those who had followed the Lamb and had no false teachings and those who have overcome the mark will be joined together to meet Yahshua in the air. Revelation 15:2-8 shows the redeemed group on the Sea of Glass singing the Song of Moses and the Lamb. ... (Revelation 19:11, 14-15) The Saints WILL REIGN with Yahshua on the earth for 1000 years. (Revelation 20:6) The Kingdoms of this world are become the Kingdom of Yahweh and His Messiah. (Revelation 11:15) In Psalms 2:6-9 again we read of Messiah's Kingdom, where Yahshua will destroy the power of the present world kingdoms and REIGN OVER the uttermost parts of the EARTH. Revelation 5:10 states "We shall REIGN ON THE EARTH." (Matthew 7:13-14) So when our Saviour calls us unto Him let us permit Him to come into our hearts and be our leader so that we may inherit eternal life. Repent! Admit we are sinners! Study and grow daily! Then we may obtain this WONDERFUL SALVATION which gives us peace and joy and the assurance of reigning with Yahshua a thousand years. Halleluyah!

This letter of January 30, 2012, is a documentation of agreement to move the operations of the Faith Bible and Tract Society from P.O. Box 321, Amherst, Ohio 44001, U.S.A., to the Assembly of Yahweh, 1017 North Gunnell Road, Eaton Rapids, Michigan 48827, U.S.A. They have agreed to reproduce the tracts and hymnals as written, keeping the original titles and acknowledging the authors without change in wording or intent of contents but may correct spelling. It has also been agreed upon to keep the name: Faith Bible and Tract Society unchanged.

The Faith Bible and Tract Society of Salem, West Virginia was originated by Clarence O. Dodd who wrote and printed his own publications and other articles written by like-minded authors. These articles appeared in the Faith Magazine which he produced in his own printing shop on site at his home from 1937 until his death in 1955. During that time, with the direct assistance and or permission from the authors, he reproduced them into tract form to facilitate distribution by postal mail when requested.

The known authors of the articles and tracts in alphabetical order are: Earl Boyd, Dr. Robert C. Darnell, C.O. Dodd, and A.B. Traina. Others may be unnamed.

After his death, his widow, Martha E. Dodd continued managing the reprinting and distribution of the tracts and hymnals from their home in Salem, West Virginia until she moved to Amherst, Ohio in 1978 to live with her daughter Mary Dodd Ling and her family. At that time, Mary assumed the guardianship of her father's work and has continued until 2012 when the Assembly of Yahweh, Eaton Rapids, Michigan, U.S.A. will begin management, printing and distribution of the tracts and hymnals.

Commentary: <u>For.</u> Indicating this verse explains the 'taking away' (captivity) of v. 5. <u>Invoked ... Name</u>. Here again is stressed the import of properly invoking the personal Name of the Creator/Father, Yahweh, as commanded of those who would be in Covenant relation with Him.¹ Also, stressed is the inevitable consequences of not doing so. Here, not only had the Covenant people not lifted up the Covenant Name in prayer and praise, they had not lived accordingly, i.e., by righteousness and judgment (right governance [personal and civil])², thus violating the Covenant even further. Indeed, they had become perverse. So Yahweh "hid His face" (removed His favor) from them and they brought on themselves the inevitable consequences He forewarned of.³

<u>AWOKE</u>. Not physically, but mentally and spiritually. Not unlike the quickening of the spirit David articulated in Ps 119:50.

<u>DELIVERED US UP</u>. Note Strong's 4127, (moog), Brown Driver & Briggs p556: **5b**. delivered into. ^bLXX "delivered us up"

<u>AS A MONUMENT</u>. Note Strong's 3027 (yawd), TW 0844: ["Hand" is interestingly employed to mean ... a "monument" ... used perhaps to establish a covenant or as religious commemorations ...]. Given the context of our verse, yawd can be seen in the figurative commemorating the inevitable consequences of national immorality. Too, for the Covenant people such was their due for perversely violating the Covenant they had made with Yahweh. Yes, as the Author of Justice, His delivering them up to captivity under their enemies served notice to all mankind of the curses for violating His Covenant, even as Israel's prior prosperity had served as a monument to the blessings for fidelity.

<u>PUNISHMENT</u>. Note the insight at TW 1577a ('awon) which in pertinent part reveals: "It was not inevitable that punishment follow [iniquity]; there was a way to escape it." Yes, man's prayers and supplication and Yah's declaration of salvation indicate the way to be rid of 'awon. Man must awaken to, confess and repent of his iniquity (Gen 44:16; Lev 16:21; Neh 9:2; Ps 32:5; 38:18 [H 19]) and it must be a plea directed to Yah (Ex 34:9; Num 14:19; Job 7:21; Ps 25:11). Yes, indeed, man must <u>change his way of life</u> (Ezk 18:30; 36:31).

Yes, as the rest of our verse indicates, the Israelites were perverse, refused to awaken, confess, repent. So the forewarned consequences did befall them. And, as intended by Yahweh, their "monument" applies and is equally a warning to all generations, even our own. For as *eternal* is the prime aspect of the Name of the perfect and unchangeable Supreme Judge of the Universe, so then is Yahweh's Covenant eternal, perfect and unchangeable, and those in Covenant relation with Him, even all men, best heed the "monument" in store for any perverse generation. Yet, it is written of salvation: "I have set before you an open door. No man can shut it: for you have little strength, but have kept My Word, and have not denied My Name."
