Editorial

EXTRA, EXTRA, READ ALL ABOUT IT

Romans 3:23 – For all have sinned, and come short of the excellence of Elohim.

Dear believer, semi-believer, sceptic, agnostic, back-slider, atheist, commandment keeper, commandment breaker, sinners all. It is time, high time, to reconnect with the Almighty Yahweh, the Creator of the Universe and His only begotten son Yahshua the Messiah. All need to wake up before it is too late and the plagues of Revelation 15 and 16 are poured out.

We all have choices. Do we want joy, happiness, a purpose driven life, a life covered by the sin cleansing blood of Yahshua the Messiah. Don't let the adversary keep you in that prison of unforgiveness of self and others. Break out, confess Yahshua as the Son of Almighty Yahweh and your Saviour and soon coming King. Yahshua is here to forgive all your/our sins and short comings. He paid the price; he paid it all on Mount Calvary.

If you haven't already, then start now living according to the scriptures, following in Yahshua's footsteps, his example. Follow after Yahshua; use his life history as an example of how to live, His birth, and his childhood. Luke 2 – the child grew and waxed strong in spirit, filled with wisdom: and the grace of Yahweh was upon him. His parents went to Jerusalem every year at the feast of the Passover (including the Passover Memorial on the 14th day of Abib and the feast of Unleavened) and when he was twelve Yahshua tarried behind after the feast. He was found in the temple, sitting in the midst of the doctors, both hearing them, and asking them questions.

Remember the miracles he performed, beginning at the marriage in Cana, when Yahshua turned the water into wine (John 2:1, 2). Prior to this Yahshua met his cousin John in Bethabara beyond Jordan, where John was baptizing. John 1:29-31 – John saw Yahshua and said, Behold the Lamb of Elohim, which taketh away the sin of the world. This is he of whom I said, After me cometh a man which is preferred before me: for he was before me. And I knew him not: but that he should be made manifest (Strong's #5319 – to render apparent, manifest, declare) to Israel, therefore am I come baptizing with water. John is saying one of his main purposes was to baptize Yahshua, the one who knew no sin, but was a forerunner of those that followed. Verses 32-34 – And John bare record, saying, I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it abode upon him. And I knew him not: but he that sent me to baptize with water, the same said unto me, Upon whom thou shalt see the Spirit descending, and remaining on him, the same is he which baptizeth with the Holy Spirit. And I saw, and bare record that this is the Son of Elohim.

Matthew 27:54 – Now when the centurion, and they that were with him watching Yahshua, saw the earthquake, and those things that were done, they feared greatly, saying, Truly this was the Son of Yahweh.

Acts 8:26-38 – Philip's charge to the man of Ethiopia, an eunuch of great authority under Candace queen of the Ethiopians, before he baptized him, in Verse 37, And Philip said, If thou believest with all thine heart, thou mayest. And he answered and said, I believe that Yahshua the Messiah is the son of Yahweh. Dear reader, sojourner, have you

made the public declaration and have you been baptized into Yahshua the Messiah? Don't put it off; the time is at hand, close to the midnight hour. Yahshua's return is soon. Acts 2:38 – Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Yahshua the Messiah for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

If we/you are nearing senior citizen age, it is high time to consider baptism. We seniors need to be examples to the younger generation. Apostle Paul in Ephesians 6:10 and 11 exhorts the believer, Finally, my brethren, be strong in Yahweh, and in the power of his might. Put on the whole armour of Elohim, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. Stand means to be steady, hold fast to the truth, not wavering, steadfast. Those that endure to the end shall be saved (Matthew 24:13).

The parable of the sower in Matthew 13 relates how when he sowed some seeds fell by the wayside, some fell on stony places, some fell among thorns, but others fell into good ground, and brought forth fruit. In Mark 4:14, the answer to what the sower is sowing is The Word. Let us take this parable to heart and sow Yahweh's Word.

John 1 says, In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with Elohim, and the Word was Elohim. Verse 4, In him was life: and the life was the light of men. Verse 14, And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us (and we beheld his majesty, the majesty as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth. In this issue of The Faith we have printed articles explaining The Feast of Weeks (also called Feast of First Fruits) and in the New Testament, Pentecost; which is the second feast of the year. The correct pattern for observing this Feast Day is found in Leviticus 23, Deuteronomy 16, Numbers 28, Joshua 5, and Acts 2. We look into Yahweh's word to glean truths to live by and to keep/observe Yahweh's Feasts. When we have come to a fork in the road in a scriptural study, we sometimes look in history/reference books to shed more light on the subject. Regarding the Feasts of Yahweh, one way to check the validity (truth) is to ask, does the reference portray the other Feasts of Yahweh according to the Scriptures.

Hitchcock's Topical Bible and Cruden's Concordance – Pentecost – (1. To be fifty days from the second day of the Passover.)

Self-Interpreting Bible Library, Volume $IV - Acts\ II - Footnote$ Chapter II. Ver. 1. Pentecost. One of the three great festivals in which all the males were required to appear at Jerusalem. It was called Pentecost (the fiftieth) because celebrated on the fiftieth, counting from the second day of the Passover, that is, seven weeks after the 16th Nisan.

WHEN TO START THE COUNT FOR THE FEAST OF WEEKS

Leviticus 23:10-16

When ye come into the land which I give unto you, and shall reap the harvest thereof, then ye shall bring a sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest unto the priest: And he shall wave the sheaf before Yahweh, to be accepted for you: on the morrow after the sabbath the priest shall wave it. ... And ye shall eat neither parched corn, nor green ears until the selfsame day that ye have brought an offering ... it shall be a statute for ever ... And ye shall count unto you from the morrow after the Sabbath, from the day that ye brought the sheaf of the wave offering; seven sabbaths shall be complete.

(Note in Rotherham – seven weeks)

(Quote from Dugger) – In Leviticus 23, v. 15, it says you are to number unto you seven Sabbaths, refers to seven weeks, as all Jews who understand the Hebrew language know. They had no word for week in their language at that time and always used the Hebrew word for Sabbath. The days were counted: "First after Sabbath, 2nd of, or after Sabbath, 3rd of Sabbath," etc. through the entire week. This same usage is

found in the N.T. concerning the resurrection of Yahshua: "First of the Sabbath," etc. Most Bible dictionaries also explain this usage correctly and avoid confusion.

The day of Pentecost, the year of the crucifixion, took place also on Friday, and not on Sunday, as many erroneously teach. Mt. Zion Reporter, Dugger.

Joshua 5:10-12

...and kept the Passover on the 14th day ...And they did eat of the old corn of the land on the morrow after the Passover (15th), unleavened cakes, and parched corn in the selfsame day. And the manna ceased on the morrow after they had eaten of the old corn of the land; neither had the children of Israel manna any more (manna ceased 16th); but they did eat of the fruit of the land of Canaan that year. (fruit – Strong's Concordance #8393, income, i.e. produce)

Rotherham – So they did eat of the yield of the land of Canaan throughout that year.

Note: They were not to eat of the new crop until they had offered the firstfruits on the morrow after the sabbath.

Editors note: The "Passover" used in the following quotes is erroneous. Feast of Unleavened is correct. Quotes from Unger's Bible Dictionary.

The Time of the Festival. The time fixed for celebrating the Pentecost is the fiftieth day from "The morrow after the Sabbath:" of the Passover (Lev. 23:11, 15, 16; or, as given in Deut. 16:9, seven full weeks after the sickle was put to the corn. The precise meaning of the word Sabbath in this connection, which determines the date for celebrating this festival, has been from time immemorial a matter of dispute. Boethusians and the Sadduces in the time of the second temple, and the Karaites since the 8th century of the Christian era, have taken "Sabbath" in the sense of the "Seventh day of the week," and have maintained that the omer was offered on the day following that weekly Sabbath which might happen to fall within the seven days of the Passover. This would make Pentecost always come on the first day of the week. Against this many arguments are presented, showing that such an opinion involves many arbitrary and improbable arrangements. Commenting on Lev. 23:15-22, K. and D. (Com., in loco) say that "Sabbaths (v. 15) signifies weeks. Consequently, "the morrow after the seventh Sabbath" v. 16 is the day after the seventh week, not after the seventh Sabbath." It is therefore evident that the Jews, who during the second temple kept Pentecost fifty days after the 16th Nisan, rightly interpreted the injunction in Lev. 23:15-22. The fiftieth day, according to the Jewish canons, may fall on the 5th, 6th, or 7th of Sivan. Page 356-357

The 16th Nisan, Cutting Barley Sheaf. This day was also called "the morrow after the Sabbath," and on it the omer of the first produce of the harvest (i.e. barley) was waved before Yahweh (Lev. 23:10-14). Page 355

Barley Sheaf: On the second feast day (16th Nisan) the first sheaf of the new harvest (barley) was symbolically offered to Yahweh by waving – not burned on the altar – Page 353

Sabbath, Morrow after the (Heb. maharath hashshabbath). A term of disputed meaning (Lev. 23:11, 15), occurring in connection with the feast of the Passover. The Sabbath referred to is not the weekly Sabbath, but the day of rest, the first day of holy convocation of the Passover, the fifteenth Abib (Nisan). As a day of rest on which no laborious work was to be performed (v. 8), the first day of the feast is called "Sabbath," irrespectively of the day of the week upon which it fell. Thus "the morrow after the Sabbath" is equivalent to "the morrow after the Passover" (Josh. 5:11).

The Savior was in the tomb 2 days of count (Abib 16 and 17). He was seen alive for 40 days, which makes 42 days. He told His disciples to tarry (wait) in Jerusalem "until ye be endued with power from on high." (Luke 24:49). They tarried seven days and received the Holy [Kodesh] Spirit on the 50th day (Acts 2).

Editors Note: The preceding article by N. Bigford (deceased) was printed in The Faith May-June, 1978.

Smith's Bible Dictionary – **Pentecost**, that is, the fiftieth day (from a Greek word meaning fiftieth), or Harvest Feast, or Feast of Weeks, may be regarded as a supplement to the Passover. It lasted for but one day. From the sixteenth of Nisan seven weeks were reckoned inclusively, and the next or fiftieth day was the day of Pentecost ...

An Expository Dictionary of New Testament Words by W.E. Vine – **Pentecost** – Pentekostos, an adjective denoting fiftieth, is used as a noun, with "day" understood, i.e., the fiftieth day after the Passover, counting from the second day of the Feast ...

The Bible Almanac – On the second day of the Festival [Feast of Unleavened Bread], a priest waved a sheaf of first-ripe barley before [Yahweh] to consecrate the beginning harvest. **The Feast of Weeks (Pentecost)**. This festival was observed 50 days after the offering of the barley sheaf at the Feast of Unleavened Bread. It marked the end of the harvest and the beginning of the seasonal offering of first fruits.

Josephus – Concerning the Festivals – 5.... But on the second day of unleavened bread, which is the sixteenth day of the month, they first partake of the fruits of the earth, for before that day they do not touch them. ... 6. When a week of weeks has passed over after this sacrifice, (which weeks contain forty and nine days,) on the fiftieth day, which is Pentecost, ...

The Feast of Weeks

The Saviour said, "I am not come to destroy the Law nor the prophets, I am not come to destroy but to fulfill," observe, obey, do (Matthew 5:17).

He was careful to keep the weekly Sabbath day. It was his custom, or habit. See Luke 4:16. And also we find him keeping the feasts of Yahweh. (See John 2:23; 4:45; 5:1; 6:4; 7:2, 10, 14, 37; 13th chapter). He was our example.

You do not read of him ever offering upon the altar, nor sacrificing a lamb, a goat, a bullock, a dove; but you do read that he kept the "moed," appointed times, the sacred [separated] days. We can safely follow him, surely!

If one objects, saying that he was just present at these feasts in order to reach more people, and teach greater crowds, we can answer that the same objection is put forth for his being present in the Temple and the synagogues on the Sabbath day. Of course we know that his purpose was to "fulfill" the Law; and the Sabbath and the other sacred appointed times (moed) stand or fall together. They are all Yahweh's "set times" and Yahshua kept them as such. Matthew 5:17, 18.

Can we not safely and surely follow the example of the One who said, "I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life," and "He that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but have the Light of Life?"

The day of Pentecost was also a Sabbath day; it was also one of the "moed" days of Leviticus 23rd chapter (verse 21). In Acts 2:1, we read of the Saviour's disciples being in worship on that sacred day, "And when the Day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place." If it is wrong to keep these sacred days, if the Master had abolished them, then why were these His disciples keeping the Pentecost Sabbath day? Why did the Holy Spirit come upon that sacred day? How could they be in one place, in one accord, except by being led by the same "Word" – by the same desire to obey? It was no accident that the Spirit came upon that day; nor was it accidently that the disciples were together at that time. It was a sacred day, and, like their Master, they wished to show their love for the Father by obedience.

Smith-Goodspeed's translation renders this text: "On the day of the Harvest Festival, they were all meeting together." Moffatt gives us: "During the course of the day of Pentecost, they were all together." Rotherham translates: "And when the day of Pentecost was filled up the number of days, they were all together with one intent."

Like obedient children, who loved their heavenly Parent, they were all together in that "holy convocation" on that "Sabbath," not accidently, not because they were meeting with the Jews to convert them; but because it was one of the "moed" days, to be kept as a Sabbath, "as a statute forever," and "throughout all generations" (Leviticus 23:21).

Yahweh has appointed set times to meet with His children, and He blesses those who are obedient as to the time and the spirit of the days.

PAUL AS TO PENTECOST – Not only had Pentecost day been a most solemn day from antiquity, and the Jews had observed it in memorial of the giving of the Law, as well as the Harvest ingathering but to the early Assembly it was additionally an especially important "moed;" for on that day, as we read in Acts 2:1, the promise of the Father had been showered down upon them in the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. For this reason, we can readily understand why Paul was anxious to meet with the other believers on Pentecost day. And so we find the record, "He hastened, if it were possible for him, to be at Jerusalem the day of Pentecost." Acts 20:16.

It is shallow reasoning to say that Paul merely wished to be at Jerusalem on Pentecost day in order to reach the many Jews who would be assembled there, and thus teach them of the Messiah. The same shallow reasoning is put forth by antagonists of the Sabbath rest, insisting that the Messiah, Paul and the other disciples went to the Sabbath meetings merely to proselyte; while the Scriptures indicate they were in the services on this sacred day because they were Sabbath keepers. Likewise, Paul tarried over the days of Unleavened Bread, and hastened onward that he might reach Jerusalem for the holy day of Pentecost, that he might keep it with others of like faith. This is indicated by the next text under consideration.

NOTHING PREVENTED PAUL — In answer to the suggestion that Paul merely was present on the "moed" holy days that he might be able to proselyte more of the worshippers who were attending the Feasts; to us the following text answers this objection completely. Paul was at Ephesus. He was entreated by them that he might tarry with them; but he did not consent to their pleas, but bade them farewell, saying, "I must by all means keep this feast that cometh in Jerusalem." (Acts 18:21). Need of the message being preached in Ephesus and pleas of friends, neither deterred Paul from hastening onward that he might "keep the moed (feast) that was coming in Jerusalem." You ask, "What Feast?" It matters not, although we believe Acts 20:16 explains what kind of feast he was attending. To those who offer the suggestion that it was a festival of the Church,* and not one of the ancient "moed" set times, we ask, Where in all the New Testament Scripture does one find where the "Church,* the disciples of the Messiah, ever kept a feast, or festival, other than the "moed" (set times) as given in the 23rd chapter of Leviticus? I know of none such!

The Memorial Supper, commonly called "The Lord's Supper," is nowhere called a "feast." True, it is to be held on one of the "moed" (set times) of Leviticus 23rd chapter, but nowhere is it designated a "feast," or a "festival." When Paul spake of "feasts" he meant those already so designated as such, as the "moed" (set times), and so understood by those who heard him. Therefore, he hastened away from Ephesus, in order that he might "keep the feast of Yahweh: (one of the "moed") which was just ahead. Whether we supply the name, "I must by all means keep this feast (of Passover, or Pentecost, or Tabernacles), it matters not. Paul was our example that the disciples should keep the "moed" set days of Yahweh.

Solomon gives us some understanding as to what is wisdom. **Proverbs 1:5** A wise man will hear [listen], and will increase learning; and a man of understanding shall attain [pay attention] to wise counsels: **6** To understand a proverb, and the interpretation; the words of the wise, and their dark sayings. **7** The fear of Yahweh is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise wisdom and instruction. **8** My son, hear [listen to] the instruction of your father, and do not forsake the law of your mother:

Psalm 111:10 The fear of Yahweh is the beginning of wisdom: a good understanding have all they that DO his commandments: his praise endures forever.

To **do** the commandments we have to know what they are. To have understanding we have to take ACTION by doing what Yahweh teaches us is right. Just knowing is not enough. The understanding of many things comes by the doing and by the obedience.

Proverbs 2:6 Yahweh gives wisdom: Out of his mouth comes knowledge and understanding. **7** He lays up sound wisdom for the righteous: he is a buckler to those who walk uprightly.

This verse points up another way of understanding what wisdom is: **Proverbs 3:35** The wise shall inherit honor: but fools shall carry away shame.

Wisdom is the opposite of being foolish. Wisdom is not the same as being smart. A smart person knows a lot of things. They may be facts, principles, or techniques for doing things. Ignorant is the opposite of smart. It just means the person doesn't have much knowledge. A generally smart person may be ignorant of many things that are not in his or her fields of interest. A wise person is usually wise in everything. They refrain from acting if they are ignorant of the matter at hand. They may ask for help when they are ignorant in some area. A wise person will often remain silent until she has listened to the conversation for a while. Smart people are sometimes not wise but wise people are usually smart because they pay attention when important information comes before them.

Proverbs 10:19 In the multitude of words sin is not lacking: but he that refrains from speaking is wise.

From that we might guess that the one who speaks the most may not be the one to whom we most need to listen.

Proverbs 17:28 Even a fool, when he holds his peace, is considered wise: and he that shuts his lips is esteemed a person of understanding.

Since wisdom can lead to being smart and to understanding, it is valuable to get wisdom. **Proverbs 8:11** Wisdom is better than rubies; and all the things that may be desired are not to be compared to it.

Part of wisdom is trying to look ahead: **Proverbs 10:5** He that gathers in summer is a wise son: but he that sleeps at harvest time is a son that causes shame.

A wise person loves to be corrected when he is in error or when there is a way he could do better. He loves it because it makes him better. A fool hates the person who corrects him because he wants to hide his error.

Proverbs 9:8 Do not reprove a scorner because he will hate you: rebuke a wise man, and he will love you.

Proverbs 14:6 A scorner seeks wisdom, and does not find it: but knowledge comes easily to him that has understanding.

Proverbs 12:15 The way of a fool is right in his own eyes: but he that hearkens to counsel is wise.

Proverbs 29:15 The rod and reproof give wisdom: but a child left to himself brings his mother to shame.

Proverbs 11:2 Pride brings shame: but wisdom is with the humble.

A wise person is careful when choosing friends: **Proverbs 13:20** He who walks with wise men shall be wise: but a companion of fools shall be destroyed.

Women need to be careful to do and say edifying and constructive things and not to do or say those little things that take just a few seconds that destroy the family and the home

Proverbs 14:1 Every wise woman builds her house: but the foolish plucks it down with her hands.

Proverbs 28:7 Whoever keeps torah is a wise son: but he that is a companion of riotous men shames his father.

Proverbs 23:24 The father of the righteous shall greatly rejoice: and he that begets a wise child shall have joy of him.

Psalm 119:98 Through your commandments you have made me wiser than my enemies: for your commandments are always with me.

Proverbs 3:7 Be not wise in your own eyes: fear Yahweh, and depart from evil.

Proverbs 14:16 A wise person fears, and departs from evil: but the fool rages, and is confident.

Psalm 19:7 The law of Yahweh is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of Yahweh is sure, making wise the simple.



The moon will be 31 hours 18 minutes old and will be up 39 minutes. If the moon is not seen in Jerusalem on the above date, the 7th month Feast dates will each begin 1 day later.
