Editorial

BLESSINGS TO ALL

Greetings and Blessings to all, Elders, Deacons, Apostles, brethren, sisters, children of the Most High Yahweh the Father and His only begotten Son Yahshua the Messiah. We write to you that your joy may be full. If we walk in the light as He is the light, we have fellowship one with another and the blood of Yahshua the Messiah His Son cleanseth us from all sin. (1 John 1).

Mankind and especially believers in Yahweh and Yahshua (the body of Yahshua) come together at the three main Feasts of the year as Yahweh declared through Moses. Sometimes an adversary comes into the midst, remember the man in the land of Uz, whose name was Job. (Job 1:1-7). This adversary said he came from going to and fro in the earth, and from walking up and down in it.

Apostle Paul states in Ephesians 6:10-13 to be strong in Yahweh, and the power of his might, and to put on the whole armour of Elohim, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of Elohim, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. Those that endure to the end shall be saved.

A question. Are we, his true body on this earth today, above being tested? Our Savior Yahshua was constantly being tested by the Pharisees and the Sadducees, lawyers, and the devil himself. If the sinless Messiah was tested in all points, are we going to escape from testings, trials and tribulations? We know we are now and will be tested in the future. How do we overcome the evil one? By the sin cleansing blood of the Lamb of Yahweh. Yahshua, the lamb slain from the foundation of the world. John 1:29-36 – ...Behold the lamb of Elohim, which taketh away the sin of the world. Yahshua is the key to abolishing the devil from around us. Acknowledge Yahshua's existence, his Ministry while on this earth, his death on the 14th of Abib as the Passover Lamb, his fulfillment of the sign of the prophet Jonah (Matthew 16:4); three days and three nights in the heart of the earth. His resurrection, his appearing in the room with his disciples, showing them his glorified body. His ascension in to the heavenlies. His sitting on the right hand of Yahweh, verified by Stephen's testimony as they stoned him in Acts 7:55-60 and in Psalm 110:1.

Yahshua left this example as one of his disciples needed discipline. He told Peter to get behind me Satan. Did Peter need that admonition at that time? Yes, he did. Peter had to own up to his failings after he denied Yahshua three times. Was Peter lost or did he repent? In Acts 2 – his great exhortation – Ye men of Israel...Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that Elohim hath made that same Yahshua whom ye have impaled, both Sovereign and Messiah. Now when they heard this, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men and Brethren, what shall we do? Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Yahshua the Messiah for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as Yahweh our Elohim shall call.

This great calling is still active today. The Holy Spirit is calling the remnant out of Babylon. Joel 2:32 – And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of Yahweh shall be delivered: for in mount Zion and in Jerusalem shall be deliverance, as Yahweh hath said, and in the remnant whom Yahweh shall call. See Zephaniah 3:13-20 – The remnant of Israel shall not do iniquity, nor speak lies; neither shall a deceitful tongue be found in their mouth: for they shall feed and lie down, and none shall make them afraid. Sing, O

daughter of Zion; shout, O Israel; be glad and rejoice with all the heart, O daughter of Jerusalem. Yahweh hath taken away thy judgments, he hath cast out thine enemy: the king of Israel, even Yahweh, is in the midst of thee: thou shalt not see evil any more....

The remnant has some great promises to look forward to; Zechariah 8:6-8 – Thus saith Yahweh of hosts; if it be marvelous in the eyes of the remnant of this people in these days, should it also be marvelous in mine eyes? saith Yahweh of hosts. Thus saith Yahweh of hosts; Behold, I will save my people from the east country, and from the west country; And I will bring them, and they shall dwell in the midst of Jerusalem: and they shall be my people, and I will be their Elohim, in truth and in righteousness. Then finally, the holy city, New Jerusalem will come down from Elohim out of heaven, (Revelation 21:1-27).

In the book of Isaiah Yahweh acknowledges Israel's history. Isaiah 63:8-16 – For he said, Surely they are my people, children that will not lie: so he was their Savior... Then he remembered the days of old, Moses, and his people, saying, Where is he that brought them up out of the sea with the shepherd of his flock? Where is he that put his Holy Spirit within him? That led them by the right hand of Moses, the pride of His strength, dividing the water before them, to make himself an everlasting name? ... Doubtless thou art our father, though Abraham be ignorant of us, and Israel acknowledge us not: thou, O Yahweh, art our father, our redeemer; thy name is from everlasting.

Moses related the commands to keep Yahweh's Sabbaths and Feast Days in Leviticus 23. In this issue of The Faith we have reports of the Feast of Unleavened Bread from 2 Feast sites in Michigan. Yes, there is a remnant keeping Yahweh's Feasts in 2015.

Noteworthy Events – Abib/Nisan 2015

World News – The Big Picture

Eclipse of the Moon – The Blood moon did appear and was seen in various parts of the world.

The Summit meeting with eleven nations trying to nurture the making and delivery of nuclear bombs.

U. S. Secretary of State trying to be a peacemaker. A peace accord was drawn up, covering the next three months to be ratified by the countries involved.

Israel's Prime Minister warning the U.S. and the world the consequences of allowing Iran to have nuclear bomb capability.

Israel's Prime Minister office was retained by Netanyahu – election close which was rare.

The President of the U.S. gave the cold shoulder to Israel when Prime Minister Netanyahu was invited to speak before Congress.

The President of the U.S. made a gesture of peace with Cuba's President at a Conference of South American Nations. This meeting was brought about by Pope Francis of Vatican City. Raul Castro was in Vatican City to thank the pope for his role in bringing this about. (Reported in USA Today 5/11/15).

All these historical events took place in the first month (Abib-Nisan) in the year 2015.

However, the actual main event on planet earth was all of Yahweh's Saints observing the month Abib-Nisan as Yahweh's Feasts; the Passover Memorial, the Feast of Unleavened Bread (Leviticus 23). These are the events we want recorded in the heavenlies.

Remember Yahweh chose Israel to be the leader of all nations.

Psalm 103:18 – Because you have kept my Word. Joel 2:32 - ... whosoever shall call on the name of Yahweh shall be delivered... (Romans 10:13-saved).

The first month (Abib) of Yahweh's Calendar was full of world news that affected mankind's spiritual and physical life. What will the seventh month of Yahweh's Calendar bring forth?

Feast of Weeks-FirstFruits-Pentecost

Luke 24:36, 49 – And as they thus spake, Yahshua himself stood in the midst of them, and saith unto them, Peace be unto you. And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.

Acts 2 – And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and began to speak with other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance. ... But Peter, standing up with the eleven, ... And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith Elohim, I will pour out of my spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams ... Then Peter said unto them, Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Yahshua the Messiah for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Acts 20:16, 22-24 – For Paul had determined to sail by Ephesus, because he would not spend the time in Asia: for he hasted, if it were possible for him, to be at Jerusalem the day of Pentecost. And now, behold, I go bound in the spirit unto Jerusalem, not knowing the things that shall befall me there: Save that the Holy Spirit witnesseth in every city, saying that bonds and afflictions abide me. But none of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, which I have received of the Master Yahshua, to testify the good news of the grace of Elohim.

1 Corinthians 15:20, 22, 23 – But now is the Messiah risen from the dead, and become the Firstfruits of them that slept. For as in Adam all die, even so in the Messiah shall all be made alive. But every man in his own order: the Messiah the Firstfruits; afterward they that are the Messiah's at his coming.

Exodus 34:22, 23 – And thou shalt observe the Feast of Weeks, of the firstfruits of wheat harvest, and the feast of ingathering at the year's end. Thrice in the year shall all your men children appear before the Sovereign Yahweh, the Elohim of Israel.

Numbers 28:26 – Also in the day of the Firstfruits, when ye bring a new meal offering unto Yahweh, after your weeks be out, ye shall have an holy convocation; ye shall do no servile work:

Leviticus 23:9-16 – And Yahweh spake unto Moses, saying, Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye be come into the land which I give unto you, and shall reap the harvest thereof, then ye shall bring a sheaf of the firstfruits of your harvest unto the priest: And he shall wave the sheaf before Yahweh, to be accepted for you: on the morrow after the Sabbath the priest shall wave it. (Septuagint says “on the morrow of the first day.” The context defines “first day” as the first day of the feast of unleavened bread.) ... And ye shall eat neither bread, nor parched corn, nor green ears, until the selfsame day that ye have brought an offering unto your Elohim: it shall be a statute for ever throughout your generations in all your dwellings. And ye shall count unto you from the morrow after the Sabbath, from the day that ye brought the sheaf of the wave offering; seven Sabbaths shall be complete: Even unto the morrow after the seventh Sabbath shall ye number fifty days ... (The Word of Yahweh Third Edition)

Deuteronomy 16:9-11 – Seven weeks shalt thou number unto thee: begin to number the seven weeks from such time as thou beginnest to put the sickle to the corn. And thou

shalt keep the Feast of Weeks unto Yahweh thy Elohim with a tribute of a freewill offering of thine hand, which thou shalt give unto Yahweh thy Elohim, according as Yahweh thy Elohim hath blessed thee: And thou shalt rejoice before Yahweh thy Elohim, thou, and thy son, and thy daughter, and thy manservant, and thy maidservant, and the Levite that is within thy gates, and the stranger, and the fatherless, and the widow, that are among you, in the place which Yahweh thy Elohim hath chosen to place his name there.

Joshua 5:10-12 – And the children of Israel encamped in Gilgal, and kept the Passover on the fourteenth day of the month at even in the plains of Jericho. And they did eat of the old corn of the land on the morrow after the Passover, unleavened cakes, and parched corn in the selfsame day. And the manna ceased on the morrow after they had eaten of the old corn of the land; neither had the children of Israel manna any more; but they did eat of the fruit of the land of Canaan that year.

PENTECOST – A solemn festival of the Jews, so called because celebrated on the fiftieth day after the sixteenth of Nisan, which was the second day of the Passover. It was called the feast of weeks, because it was celebrated seven weeks after the Passover. ... (American Dictionary of the English Language, Noah Webster 1828)

The Feast of Weeks (Pentecost). This festival was observed 50 days after the offering of the barley sheaf at the Feast of Unleavened Bread. (On the second day of the festival, a priest waved a sheaf of first-ripe barley before the Lord [Yahweh]). It marked the end of the harvest and the beginning of the seasonal offering of first fruits (Exod. 23:16; Lev. 23:15-21; Num. 28:26-31; Deut. 16:9-12). This one-day festival was observed as a Sabbath with a holy gathering at the tabernacle. (The Bible Almanac)

First-fruits. 2. On the morrow after the Passover Sabbath i.e. on the 16th of Nisan, a sheaf of new corn was to be brought to the priest and waved before the altar, in acknowledgement of the gift of fruitfulness (Lev. 23:5, 6, 10, 12). (Key to the Bible)

Pentecost. 1. To be fifty days from the second day of the Passover. Lev. 23:15 – And ye shall count unto you from the morrow after the sabbath, from the day that ye brought the sheaf of the wave offering; seven sabbaths shall be complete. 16. Even unto the morrow after the seventh Sabbath shall you number fifty days.... Deut. 16:9 – Seven weeks shall thou number unto thee: begin to number the seven weeks from such time as thou beginnest to put the sickle to the corn. (Hitchcock's Topical Bible and Cruden's Concordance)

SHABUOTH – (weeks; more accurately, Hag Hashabuoth, Feast of Weeks), a festival celebrated in the month of Sivan; its name is derived from the fact that it was celebrated in Bible times seven weeks after the bringing of a sheaf of barley as an offering on the festival of Passover (Lev. 23:15, 16). It is denoted in the Bible also by the names *yom habikkurim* (day of first-fruits; Num. 28:26) and *hag hakatzir* (feast of harvest; Ex. 23:16). (The Universal Jewish Encyclopedia)

Pentecost, that is, the fiftieth day (from a Greek word meaning fiftieth), or Harvest Feast, or Feast of Weeks, may be regarded as a supplement to the Passover. It lasted for but one day. From the sixteenth of Nisan seven weeks were reckoned inclusively, and the next or fiftieth day was the day of Pentecost. (Smith's Bible Dictionary)

Pentecost – Pentekostos, an adjective denoting fiftieth, is used as a noun, with “day” understood, i.e., the fiftieth day after the Passover, counting from the second day of the Feast... (An Expository Dictionary of New Testament Words by W.E. Vine)

What's in a Name?

In the beginning Elohim created the heaven and the earth...

Then men began to call upon the Name of Yahweh. Genesis 4:26

And there he (Abraham) built an altar unto Yahweh and called upon the Name of Yahweh. Genesis 12:8

Feast of Unleavened Bread

The Passover Season arrived in Michigan April 4, 2015, beginning at sunset April 3, 2015. The spring Feasts of Yahweh are great blessings for Yahweh's Saints. See Leviticus 23 and Deuteronomy 16. The celebration and memorial of our Savior Yahshua the Messiah's trial of His Faith. The example of his steadfast love for all of us – Yahweh's creation, all of us that were made in His image, His chosen, peculiar people.

Yahshua's resurrection from the rich man's (Joseph of Arimathaea) grave gives the believers the great Hope of living in the Kingdom Yahshua went to prepare for us. Apostle Paul wrote in 1 Corinthians 15:19 – If in this life only we have hope in the Messiah, we are of all men most miserable. Yahweh does not want us miserable. He wants us to enjoy His Sabbaths, His Feast Days, all His commands. Yahweh tells us to rejoice in His Feasts. Leviticus 23:40 -...and ye shall rejoice before Yahweh your Elohim seven days.

The Passover Memorial brought a nice-sized dedicated group to partake of the emblems – the unleavened bread representing Yahshua's body, and the fruit of the vine representing Yahshua's blood which was shed for us. This Service is solemn, serious and soul-searching; followed by the foot-washing service which shows our willingness to humble ourselves by kneeling down and washing one another's feet. The example was recorded in John 13:4-17 – He (Yahshua) riseth from supper, and laid aside his garments; and took a towel, and girded himself. After that he poureth water into a bason, and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe them with the towel wherewith he was girded...Yahshua answered and said unto him, What I do thou knowest not now; but thou shalt know hereafter... For I have given you an example, that ye should do as I have done to you. Verily, verily, I say unto you, The servant is not greater than his master; neither he that is sent greater than he that sent him. If ye know these things, happy (Strong's 3107-supremely blest) are ye if ye do them.

When we follow Yahshua the Messiah's examples, we will be blessed. Luke 4:16, 17 – ...as his custom was, he went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up for to read. And there was delivered unto him the book of the prophet Isaiah (Isaiah 53).

During the Feast there were regular daily services (some evening meetings), a bible study one afternoon, with many song specials and offerings throughout. Messages included: Fear Yahweh and Keep His Commandments; Yahweh is in the Details; Israel Went out with a High Hand; Ephraim and Manasseh-Where They Are Now; Psalm 91-Yahweh's Protection; Salvation.

Yahweh's Feasts are always a blessing to attend, to celebrate. It is always a good thing to give thanks unto Yahweh. HalleluYah, Hosanna, Praise Yahweh!

The Feast of Unleavened Bread at Gull Lake

A lawyer once tested our Messiah asking “what is the great commandment in the Law?” Our Messiah simply answered that the “great commandment” was two fold, and it was centered on relationship, Our Father in Heaven first then one another second. He told him that the reason for the law and the prophets was to teach men in detail, these principles (Matt 22:31-40). Our lives do not belong to us, we are just stewards of these vessels that we dwell in called our body (1 Corinthians 6:19, 20). YHWH has given us these vessels and blessed us with the ability to choose what we will do with them. He has given us instructions of what will lead to life, and warned us of what will lead to death (Deuteronomy 30:11-20). He wants us to cherish this temporary dwelling as He does. To use it to glorify Him and draw others to Him revealing the hope that is in store for all of those who would yield to His will (John 17:1-26). He does not want us to be obedient out of want or obligation but out of true loving devotion (Psalm 34:1-22).

In addition to the weekly Sabbath, YHWH has instructed us of three times throughout the year when He wants to meet with us. He has set aside these times for instruction, refreshment, replenishment, fellowship, and worship, with others on this same path. He spells out those details in Leviticus 23, but His purpose and timing for them was laid out well before Mt Sinai. In Genesis 1:14 YHWH tells us the reason that He placed the sun, moon and stars in their courses; 1) to divide day from night 2) for signs 3) for seasons 4) for days 5) for years. This 3rd reason is the one we read about in Leviticus 23. The Hebrew word here in Genesis “mo-ade”, translated here as “season” is the same word translated in Leviticus 23:2, 4 as “Feasts”. YHWH has set into motion from creation times to meet with those that He formed into His image and likeness (Gen 1:26). He created the weekly Sabbaths and Appointed times for us to meet with Him (Gen 1:14, Lev 23, Mark 2:27). He goes into great detail in His word the reasons for these appointed times.

There are 3 appointed times a year when YHWH commands the entire nation to appear before Him. When they do, He tells all the males to not appear before Him empty (Exodus 23:14-22, Deuteronomy 16:16). These 3 feasts are pilgrimage feasts where YHWH calls us to come out of the world and rejoice before Him. Many believers pay these feasts tribute in name only, and stay away in practice. Many have reasons that they feel are acceptable reasons for not appearing before YHWH, Money, Jobs, School, obligations, etc. (Matthew 22:1-14). YHWH promises us that He will not put burdens on us that we can't bear, or ask us to do something we can't do. In fact He makes provision for us in His plan so that if we believe Him, put our trust and confidence in Him, that He will never let us down (Exodus 34:22-24).

From birth, my life (as I am sure yours has been), has been filled with change. My Father was a finish carpenter, and our family moved from place to place following his work. We changed towns, houses, and schools on a regular basis, some 30 times by the time I was 18. Throughout this life of constant change, there were 2 things I could count on; 1) my Church {where I learned of YHWH [although I did not grow up knowing his name] through the teaching of His scriptures} 2) our family. The Sabbath and the Holy Days were always something that we looked forward to, and some of my fondest memories were centered on them. No matter where we went, our family would get rejuvenated along with other believers, by YHWH's word and our common walk together

in that word. I cherish those times because I was able to be around other children that were just like me, and my parents with others just like them, learning to be in the world but not of the world.

Through my parents example I have, to the best of my understanding, kept the Sabbath and Holy Days my whole life. Growing up I thought we were truly keeping the Feast of Unleavened Bread; we did not eat anything leavened for 7 days and for 7 days we ate unleavened bread. My Father would not work on the High Days at the beginning and end of the Feast, and we would gather with other believers for worship. We did what we thought was keeping the feast, but we were only keeping it in part. We never came out of the world to rejoice before Him for the entire 7 days as He instructed. It has only been in the past 9 years that my wife, children and I have done this. In reflecting back I have been able to see that my parents were seeking YHWH, but did not fully understand his purpose or all of the details that He had for them. As we each go along on this journey, YHWH will continue to reveal things in our lives that need to be changed. He does not want us to be blown by every wind of doctrine, but wants us to be moldable and shapeable by Him (Ephesians 4:11-16). He is patient with us as we seek His face (1 Corinthians 13). I believe that the rest of our life will be like this. As we go along and seek Him, He will open up more and more to us. Over the past 40 years YHWH has opened my eyes to more and more of His way, in so doing He has given me time to change my habits and understanding how to change to look more like Him. YHWH is a creator and in His creation He plants seeds. He waters them then gives them time to grow. All the time those seeds are growing; He is weeding His garden so that in it the plants that He is cultivating will bear fruit.

You may be asking yourself, why this article is titled “The Feast of Unleavened Bread at Gull Lake”. You may be thinking “I have not read anything at all about Gull Lake”, and you would be right. Yes, I could have written first and told you of the beautiful Lake view that we had this spring. How we were able to see the ice pass away on the lake changing into moving water. I could have expounded on all of the miracles and healings that we were part of and witness to. I could have told you of the amazing messages that we heard, or how our Father worked out a reasonable rate for our accommodations, and how seemingly closed doors were opened. I could have inspired you with how so many from so far away came to spend this time with one another, some keeping the Feast for the very first time.

I could have shared the many personal insights that YHWH revealed to me, from “the planning for”, to “the keeping of” the Feast. How He allowed me to see His Hand work to bring events into perfect timing to meet the needs of so many. You would have been moved in your spirit to know of the unity that we had there with such a diverse group from many upbringings, understandings and back grounds. While some were only able to be there for part of the time, we were all moved in one accord with one spirit to be drawn to our Heavenly Father and His son, to desire more of Him and less of the world.

If I had done that first it would have been in vain. You see YHWH wants us to seek Him first, only then can we truly experience all of the beauty, and wonder that He has for us (Matthew 6:13). He wants us to be in Love with Him and commit ourselves wholly and completely to Him with no reservations, holding nothing back (Deuteronomy 10:12-20, Matthew 11:28-30). It is only then that we can truly begin to discover the plans that He has for us (Proverbs 3:1-6). Because He is not after our blind obedience but our heart, only then will He be pleased with our offerings and sacrifices (Psalms 51, Romans 12).

This past spring a diverse group gathered together to worship the King at one of His Appointed times. A small handful of brethren from a couple of fellowships came together some months before, to organize and host this Feast. We left our jobs, our homes, and our neighbors behind to meet before the King with one another. We trusted Him to keep His word and look after our things while we were away (Exodus 34:24). We gathered at Gull Lake, Michigan, where we were thankful for the time that YHWH gave us to meet and see firsthand His work. We washed feet, we partook of His Passover, we sang, we played music, we served, we worshiped, we listened, we prayed, we laughed, we cried, we danced, we played, and we truly feasted 3 times each day together. In short we rejoiced. We rejoiced that we were able to be a part of one of His rehearsals, we didn't all have the same understanding on all things, but we were all hungry to know Him more and be vessels that He is cleaning for His purpose. We look forward to a time to come when all flesh will know our King Yahshua the Messiah who gave his life that we might not perish, but have everlasting life. A time when all will come to worship at His feet and say "blessed is He who comes in the name of YHWH".

I would like you to consider for a moment what your goals are for the rest of this life. How are you going about meeting those goals? Then I want to ask you to take your plans for your life and line them up with YHWH's plans for your life. I always wondered what I wanted to be when I grew up, and maybe you wondered that too. What career to pursue, how much money would you make, where you would live, maybe you're thinking about those things now. You see, we are all YHWH's children and He has given us all different talents and gifts. He wants us to use those talents and gifts together with others to form His body of believers, a tabernacle where He wants to dwell forever. He has offered to give us eternal life, but only if we will put Him first in all things. If we are willing to submit to Him, He has promised to lead us in the direction that we need to go, because He knows what's best for us. We just have to be patient enough to wait for it (Matthew 6:25-33). He is willing to go the distance with us, and He wants us by His side all the way (Leviticus 25:23).

If you don't know what your talents or gifts are or what He wants, or expects from you, then this may help..... He wants you to be a peculiar treasure to Him, a Kingdom of priests. He wants you to be a part of His holy and set apart people (Exodus 19:5, 6). He wants you to be about His business (Luke 2:41-52). How will you do this you might ask? How will you reach these goals? He has given you His Holy Spirit (John 14:26, 27) and set aside time throughout the year to meet with you and share those plans with you (Leviticus 23). Won't you take the time to come meet with Him...won't you come and keep His appointed times? (Isaiah 55:1-13).

Our time here is short (Psalm 90:1-17). Many are called but few are chosen (Matthew 22:1-14).

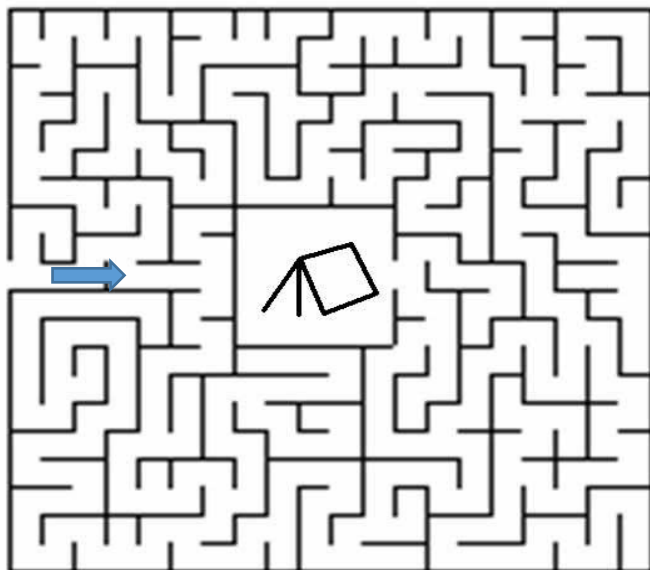
