It is supported by "called out ones of Yahweh," which is the meaning of "Assembly of Yahweh." It is for those hearing and heeding the call of Revelation 18:4, and is proclaiming to the world that Yahweh reigns, Psalm 96.

THE POWER OF PRAYER

“And when thou prayest, thou shalt not be as the hypocrites are: for they love to pray standing in the synagogues and in the corners of the streets, that they may be seen of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward.”

“But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and when thou has shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret; and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly.” Matthew 6:5-6

For the Believer to have a living active faith, there must be daily intercourse with the heavenly Father. The mind and heart may be drawn toward Him, or reflect upon His works, His mercies and His blessings, but this is not in the fullest sense communing with Yahweh. Fully communing with Him is talking with Him about daily concerns or needs, and then being still long enough to listen for His guidance and direction.

Prayer is opening our heart to the heart of Yahweh, as we would share intimately with a spouse or a close friend. Prayer does not bring Elohim down to man, but elevates man to a spiritual level, whereby he has his spirit opened to understand the will of Yahweh.

Yahweh speaks to His children in many ways: by the influence of His Spirit, His Holy [Kodesh] Word, through brethren who are moved in Gifts of the Spirit to speak a word from Yahweh, and He can even speak to us through his creation at times. To receive answers to prayer, for personal needs or for a brother in the BODY of the Messiah, requires a hearing heart. Our ability to hear becomes stronger through repeated fellowship and communion with the Heavenly Father. His sheep know the voice of their Shepherd (John 10).

Those who have earnestly sought to develop a prayer life know the discipline, faithfulness and perseverance that are required. Yahshua taught the first twelve disciples how to pray. If the disciples, who saw Yahshua face-to-face daily, saw the miracles, and heard the Kingdom Message first hand, had to be taught how to talk with their Heavenly Father, how much more you and I need the instruction of our Master – Yahshua.

Yahshua assured the disciples that Yahweh cared about their needs, and that He would not only hear but would answer their petitions and prayers. We can approach Yahweh with this same confidence, knowing that our Father is merciful and it is His good pleasure to give us the Kingdom.

Yahshua set the example for us; he did nothing without seeking his Father in prayer. He often withdrew from the crowds to spend all night talking to his Father. The selection of the twelve disciples occurred immediately following an all-night prayer session.

Yahshua identified with each Believer in his needs and human weakness, by demonstrating that each of us needs a daily supply of strength and faith to overcome the flesh, the world and the devil. Just because we prayed yesterday, or even today, does not mean that we are equipped to handle the tests of tomorrow....

If the Son of Yahweh, who was without sin, recognized that in the flesh He needed Yahweh's enabling power and strength, and He sought it with strong crying and tears; ought not we mortals saved by grace, recognize our great need for the power of Yahweh's Spirit....

A sign of great faith is a man's prayer life. Those who believe Yahweh hears, cares, and answers prayer, spend much time in their secret closet.

TO WHAT “CHURCH” DO YOU BELONG?

With several hundred different denominations existing in the world, a truth seeker might ask, “Which one is the true ‘church?’” Is one of these organizations the true “church?” Just what makes up the true “church” of Yahweh (Acts 12:5; 20:28; 1 Cor. 11:16 and others)?

First of all, it would be good to properly define the term, “church.” Looking to the Greek, from which we get the translation, “church” in the New Testament, we find that the word means, “the called out ones.” In the Old Testament we do not find the word, “church” (King James translation); but rather we find “assembly” or “congregation.” (If you do not have a Strong's exhaustive concordance of the Scriptures, we urge you to get one to use with a King James translation. With it you can find any word in the Scriptures, the texts where it is used, and the meaning from the Hebrew and Greek dictionaries. Thus you can find a text, the location of which you did not know; and also, certain apparent inconsistencies are cleared up by learning better meanings of words.) From this we learn that the term, “church,” can be misleading, as it really means a calling out, assembly, congregation, the people, the called out ones.

Who are these people? How are they called out? Do they make an assembly themselves, and where they choose? Have you ever heard someone say that they are trying to build a congregation here or there, or that they would like to start an assembly where they live? We learn from the Scriptures that this is not our doing; for we read, “. . . the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, as many as YAHWEH our Mighty One SHALL CALL.” (Acts 2:39). Yahweh does the calling. We also read, “. . . and YAHWEH ADDED to the assembly daily such as should be saved.” (Acts 2:47); thus Yahweh does the calling and the adding to the assembly-not us. Yahweh may use us to give meat in due season to one He is calling (Matthew 24:45), but it is He that calls, and He that builds the true assembly. We read, “Except Yahweh build the house, they labour in vain that build it; except Yahweh keep the city, the watchman waketh in vain.” (Psalm 127:1). Just as Yahweh calls and builds His true assembly-not men; in like manner, no man can take away from, or put people out of, the true assembly - the called out group: Yahshua said, “My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow ME; and I give unto them everlasting life; and they shall never perish, neither shall anyone pluck them out of my hand.” (John 10:27, 28); thus we need have no concern just because a man says, “I am putting you out of our organization.” or, “You are on probation in this assembly.” It is our relationship with Yahweh that we must consider. To be saved, we need to remain a called out one of Yahweh, not a member of an organization of men.

Can you now understand what is the called out group that is to be saved? It is the congregation or assembly of Yahweh, and it is made up of the individual saints around the world, wherever they may be, gathering together in local assemblies, or meetings, wherever they are able (Hebrews 10:25). Some of these people live in the vicinity of Holt, Michigan, and edit THE FAITH magazine – “Declare His esteem among the heathen, His wonders among all people. Say among the heathen, Yahweh reigneth ...” (Psalms 96:3, 10). This is for all of Yahweh's people (the assembly) to do. Just because we here, a local assembly, part of the great world wide assembly, are editing THE FAITH, does not mean that we are to be looked upon as world headquarters for the truth or that we are a “church” of abundant

riches. Yahweh does, however, give us enough to do the work (see Malachi 3:10 - Septuagint Bible); and as He gives us more, we feel we should do more. The point is, we are just a few of Yahweh's people here, trying to serve Him. We did not ask for "THE FAITH MAGAZINE;" but rather, we were asked to take it. We do not take money from "THE FAITH" for ourselves; but rather, we work at other jobs (or are retired) and contribute to THE FAITH. We believe this best, as we understand Paul did, so that the glad tidings of Messiah be not hindered because of it (I Corinthians 9:12, 15, & 19). There would be too great a tendency to print what pleased those paying, even though it might not be quite the pure truth.

THE FAITH is meant for the entire assembly - all who want it. All may take part in the making of it. No one needs to join with us. They are already joined with us if they are of the assembly of Yahweh. Just think, you do not have to join anything. Yahweh puts you in His assembly. How wonderful to be in His assembly, not in any man-made organization, with rules that they have lain down. HalleluYah!

Thank you Yahweh for calling us to Your group and putting us in. May we never think that this is not a sufficient group to be in, and think that we must join something else. How wonderful that no matter where on earth we meet others in Your group, Yahweh, we know that we are members of the same congregation, because You have put us into it; we have not had to sign our name on any dotted line that man has made. We just want our name written in the Lamb's book of life (Rev. 3:5; 20:12; 21:27). We know Your people by their fruits (Matthew 7:20). HalleluYah!

We are in the same group even though we may never have seen one another. Our statement of doctrine has been written up for many, many years. When we see people following this doctrine, we know they are Yahweh's people, and therefore, in the assembly of Yahweh. Yahweh inspired this doctrine to be written (II Timothy 3:16). It is found in a book. The book has chapters. Genesis is the first chapter, and Revelation, the last. This is Yahweh's Word, and it is the truth (John 17:17). It is called Scripture. It is Scripture of truth (Daniel 10:21). Some people try to prove false doctrine by not using all the Scripture. We must be very careful about doing such a devilish thing. We are warned about this in the Scriptures (Deut. 4:2; Prov. 30:5, 6; Rev. 22:19). We should love ALL the truth, which is the Scripture. If we do not love it, Yahweh will let us believe lies (II Thess. 2:10, 11). Yahweh's set apart Spirit will lead us to truth, and bring it to mind when we need it, or when we may give it as meat in due season for someone else: "But the Comforter, the set apart Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you. Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth; for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, shall he speak; and he will shew you things to come. But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you; but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is the truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him." (John 14:26; 16:13; I John 2:27).

Let us love ALL truths, and follow them all, so that we will not believe lies about any one truth. The Scripture teaches us to prove ALL things (I Thess. 5:21). Let us love it all so we will not believe lies about anything. This can include truths of eating, health, and healing, as well as weightier matters; and it is nice to know the truth of the Kingdom, so

that we will know where we may spend the 1000 year reign with Yahshua the King. If we do not love this truth, we may not study HARD, proving it as we are commanded; and therefore we may believe a lie about it. We are not to be antagonistic toward truth or others in the faith, but, “With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love; endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.” (Ephesians 4:2-3). We should be submissive, loving whatever the Scriptures say, even though they may say something contrary to what we have believed. What do we love most - Yahweh's Word, or our ideas?

LEARNING TRUTH AND UNLEARNING ERROR

We find a text (Phil 3:13), which applies unto our search for Scriptural knowledge, although Apostle Saul's meaning is more inclusive. He says, "This one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before. I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of Yahweh in the Messiah Yahshua."

Most of us have had religious experiences in our past lives. Most have had religious parents and were trained in the religions of our fathers and mothers. We revere them, we honor their endeavors to train us for life eternal [everlasting], and so many of us are loath to relinquish some of the teachings we received in our former years.

The fact that we cling to the "church teachings" of our former life, bringing them with us into the "true way," thus "muddying" the clear waters of truth, causes the divisions that are manifest among the true children of Yahweh.

We must forget those things behind – whether we were Catholic, Methodist, Baptist, Pentecostal, Adventist, or Sabbatarian. We must forget every teaching and start over again. Yes, I mean just that. If you had a truth in the former church of your experience, it will not hurt to examine that subject anew, under the search light of Yahweh's Scriptures. If it is truth, it will not be harmed. If it is error you have thought truth, then you are the wiser.

My experience in striving to work with brethren, equally honest and sincere and consecrated as am I, is one of bitter trial, when such forget to leave doctrines of their church days behind, but bring them in and mix them with their new found truth.

Back in 1929, when Yahweh awakened me to the knowledge that there were truths in His blessed old Book that the churches did not know, I rejoiced greatly and began to study diligently; but I soon came to the conclusion that I could not make the Scriptures harmonize with the creeds and doctrines of the Churches. I knew its doctrines well, for was I not the teacher of a "Men's Bible Class" in a large city church, whose membership consisted of learned and successful businessmen? I had to know, and I did know, Methodist doctrines; but these I delegated to the scrap heap when I went to digging for truth. And, praise Yahweh, when I learned a truth from the Scriptures, if it harmonized with the Methodists, the Baptists, the Adventists, the Pentecostals, the Sabbatarians, or other sectarians, I rejoiced with them; but if the Scriptures taught another fact, and it disagreed with all of them, then I rejoiced the greater, for Yahweh was leading me on. Halleluyah.

Now, beloved brother, or sister, if you are desirous of learning the truth, let the Holy Spirit lead, but do not hinder its work in your life. Forget your former teachings – learn everything anew – start over – try your former doctrines by Yahweh's Word, and "hold fast to that which is good." 1 Thess. 5:21.

You will find, beloved, it is much harder to unlearn error than it is to learn truth. Try and see!

Exodus 10:3: And Moses and Aaron came in unto Pharaoh, and said unto him, Thus saith Yahweh Almighty of the Hebrews, How long wilt thou refuse to **humble** thyself before me? Let my people go, that they may serve me. (History is repeating itself today, in assemblies and the world of today.)

Deuteronomy 8:2: And thou shalt remember all the way which Yahweh thy Creator led thee these forty years in the wilderness, to **humble** thee, and to prove thee, to know what was in thine heart, whether thou wouldest keep his commandments, or no.

Deuteronomy 8:16: Who fed thee in the wilderness with manna, which thy fathers knew not, that he might **humble** thee, and that he might prove thee, to do thee good at thy latter end;

Judges 19:24: Behold, here is my daughter a maiden, and his concubine; them I will bring out now, and **humble** ye them, and do with them what seemeth good unto you: but unto this man do not so vile a thing.

2 Chronicles 7:14: **If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.**

2 Chronicles 34:27: **Because thine heart was tender, and thou didst humble thyself before Yahweh, when thou heardest his words against this place, and against the inhabitants thereof, and humbledst thyself before me, and didst rend thy clothes, and weep before me; I have even heard thee also, saith Yahweh.**

Job 22:29: When men are cast down, then thou shalt say, There is lifting up; and he shall save the **humble** person.

Psalms 9:12: When he maketh inquisition for blood, he remembereth them: he forgetteth not the cry of the **humble**.

Psalms 10:12: Arise, O Yahweh; O Yahweh, lift up thine hand: forget not the **humble**.

Psalms 10:17: Yahweh, thou hast heard the desire of the **humble**: thou wilt prepare their heart, thou wilt cause thine ear to hear:

Psalms 34:2: My soul shall make her boast in Yahweh: the **humble** shall hear thereof, and be glad.

Psalms 69:32: The **humble** shall see this, and be glad: and your heart shall live that seek Yahweh.

Proverbs 6:3: Do this now, my son, deliver thyself, when thou art come into the hand of thy friend; go, **humble** thyself, and make sure thy friend.

Proverbs 16:19: Better it is to be of an **humble spirit** with the lowly, than to divide the spoil with the proud.

Proverbs 29:23: A man's pride shall bring him low: but honour shall uphold the **humble in spirit**.

Isaiah 57:15: For thus saith the high and lofty One that inhabiteth eternity, whose name is Separated; I dwell in the high and separated place, with him also that is of a contrite and **humble spirit, to revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones.**

Jeremiah 13:18: Say unto the king and to the queen, **Humble** yourselves, sit down: for your principalities shall come down, even the crown of your honour. (Note: Even kings and queens should **humble themselves, etc., before Yahweh.**)

Matthew 18:4: **Whosoever therefore shall humble himself as this little child, the same is greatest in the kingdom of heaven.**

Matthew 23:12: And whosoever shall exalt himself shall be abased; and **he that shall humble himself shall be exalted.**

2 Corinthians 12:21: And lest, when I come again, my Yahweh will **humble** me among you, and that I shall bewail many which have sinned already, and have not repented of the uncleanness and fornication and lasciviousness which they have committed.

James 4:6: But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, Yahweh resisteth the proud, but giveth grace unto the **humble**.

James 4:10: **Humble** yourselves in the sight of Yahweh, and He shall lift you up.

1 Peter 5:5: Likewise, ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yea, all of you be subject one to another, and be clothed with **humility**: for Yahweh resisteth the proud, and giveth grace to the **humble**.

1 Peter 5:6: **Humble** yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of Yahweh, that he may exalt you in due time:

Yahweh is looking for a **humble** people before Him ... Ones that are spiritually forceful of worshipping and serving Him in all of His Spiritual Ways.
